This is a follow up to our joint, open letter dated 23 January 2020, to let you know that Joy Morrissey MP has now joined our calls to withdraw the draft Local Plan for Chiltern and South Bucks.

Ms Morrissey said:

*"I welcome this initiative and fully support it. We must protect our green belt for future generations. We need a South Bucks Local Plan that works for everyone, not just developers. I would strongly urge that the plan be withdrawn. We need a local plan that is less intrusive on our green belt while providing vital infrastructure and the homes we actually need not just the ones developers want to build."*
