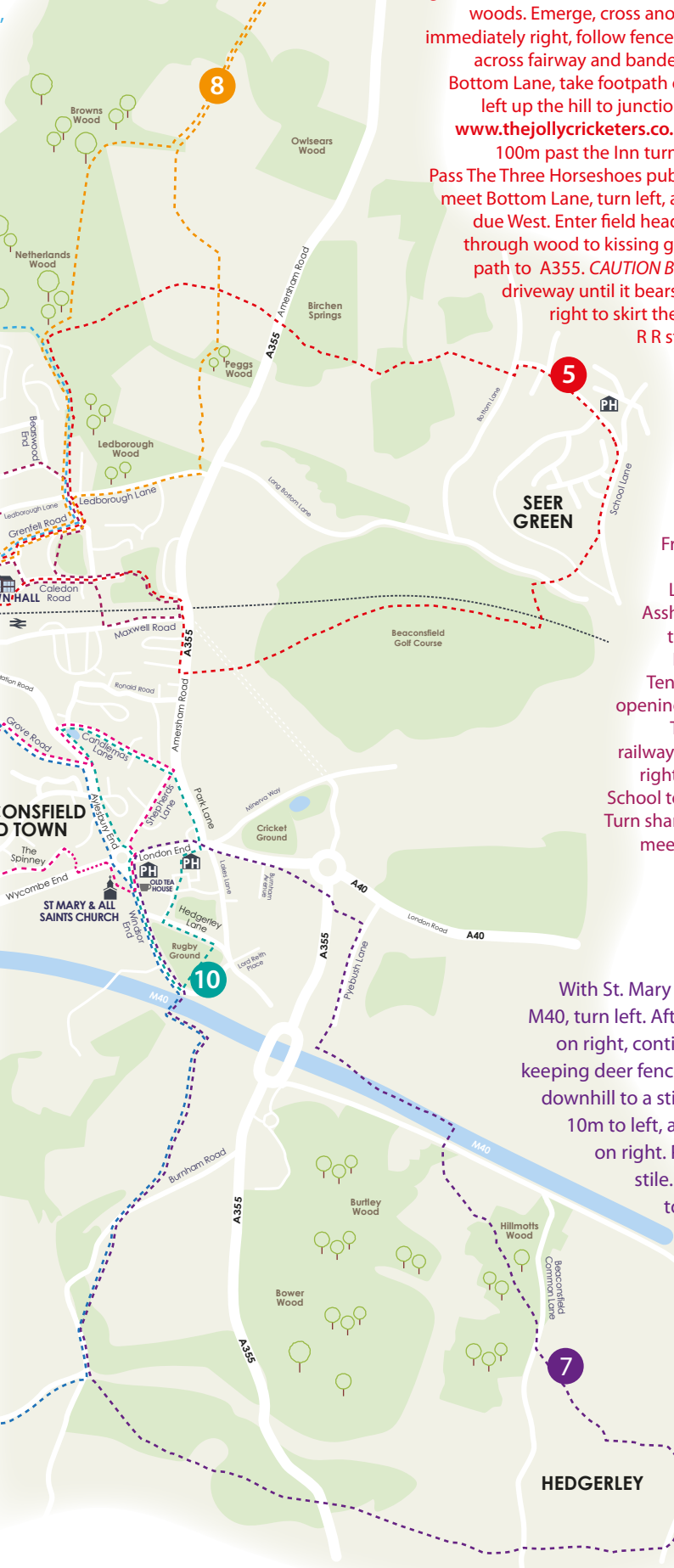

5 Beaconsfield New Town, Town Hall to Seer Green
 4.5 mile/7.2km - through fields & woods



From Town Hall Green turn left and left again down Station Approach. Bear left up footpath. Keep right at the top, continue on Caledon Road into One Tree Lane. Take narrow road between two houses to One Tree Meadow, turn diagonally right between two trees to far corner, enter wood. Proceed keeping houses on left to path parallel to railway. Bear left to A355. Turn right, over bridge, cross Maxwell Road, proceed up Amersham Road. After about 400m look out for footpath and stile on the opposite side. **CAUTION BUSY ROAD.** Cross, take path across field to reach woods, over a stile, enter woods and emerge onto golf course. **CAUTION golf balls can kill!** Go between tees on left and right, cross straight over towards a signpost and wide path into woods. Emerge, cross another fairway, bunker to your right into woods. After 300m turn left over bridge, immediately right, follow fence line. Head towards distant shed, then follow signpost directing you diagonally across fairway and banded green posts, into woods and a kissing gate. **CAUTION BUSY ROAD.** Cross Long Bottom Lane, take footpath opposite up hill, bear left, cross a minor road and on to reach School Lane, turn left up the hill to junction with Orchard Road. Either take Orchard Road, or to reach The Jolly Cricketers, www.thejollycricketers.co.uk continue up School Lane to the Inn on your right. On leaving the Cricketers, 100m past the Inn turn left into Church Road and rejoin the route by turning right into Orchard Road. Follow Orchard Road to meet Bottom Lane, turn left, after 50m take footpath to your right, head up the field, large tree to your right, due West. Enter field heading down, wood to your left, to gate in corner. Continue straight on up the hill through wood to kissing gate, through gate, diagonally across field to kissing gate and into wood. Follow path to A355. **CAUTION BUSY ROAD.** Cross A355 opposite gate beside driveway, through gate, alongside driveway until it bears right, follow waymark sign to turn left, after 50m enter field, turn immediately right to skirt the field to corner, enter the wood. Follow arrows White (W) Red (R) W W W R R W R R straight through wood to wooden fence. Turn left, south down footpath behind houses, keeping fence to your right all the way to Ledborough Lane. Cross, go down Wilton Road, right into Grenfell Road, cross St Michael's Green diagonally into Warwick Road. Proceed along Warwick Road, to Penn Road, left pass Waitrose to your start.

6 Beaconsfield New Town Library to One Tree Meadow
 2 mile/3.2km - on pavements & fields



From Library, turn right and take the left turn into a private car park. Go through alleyway onto Penn Road, cross at the crossing, turn left, then right into Ledborough Lane, then left into Sandelswood End. After 200m turn right along Assheton Road, bear half right into Bearswood End. Take the path and turn right at the T-junction of paths to emerge on Ledborough Lane again. Cross into Wilton Road, turn right into Grenfell Road and after about 50m enter the Beaconsfield Tennis Club, walk beside the courts furthest away from the pavilion, exit by hedge opening after last court. Turn left, shortly turn left again along Caledon Road into One Tree Lane. Once in the Meadow bear half right to the backs of house and on to railway line. Pass between houses on left and railway to the right and onto A355. Turn right and right again into Maxwell Road. Proceed pass the Curzon Centre, St Mary's School to take footpath to your right until it emerges to re-join Caledon Road, turn left. Turn sharp right after 400m to reach St Michael's Church, turn left into Warwick Road to meet Penn Road. Turn right along the lay by and cross at the crossing. Retrace your steps through the alleyway to your start.

7 Beaconsfield Old Town to Hedgerley
 6.5 mile/10.4km - on footpaths, stiles & minor roads



With St. Mary & All Saints Church on right, walk down Windsor End, take footpath across M40, turn left. After 200m take a right, cross the road and enter field. Pass Angling Club lake on right, continue over stiles for 800m to Burnham Road. Through kissing gate opposite, keeping deer fence on left continue to Hollybush Wood. Take permitted path straight ahead, downhill to a stile. **BEWARE** barbed wire. Turn right through kissing gate to road. Take path 10m to left, ascend through trees, onwards follow white arrows, passing Jennings Farm on right. Pass farm buildings, follow pointer to right; over a stile; turn left to another stile. Turn immediately right, follow footpath, skirt the field until you reach stile to Harehatch Lane, turn left until you reach the A355. **CAUTION BUSY ROAD.** Cross, take bridleway due east, cross road, enter Kiln Lane. After 500m, enter Hedgerley, turn left at T-junction. The White Horse is on the right. www.thewhitehorsehedgerley.co.uk Take footpath after Inn, diagonally to your left, due north-west to near corner of Sutton's Wood, bear left in the field, along the wood edge. Go right at the corner of the wood, through the gap and aim diagonally across the field and a gap in the hedge. Continue NW to exit at Beaconsfield Common Lane. Cross lane 50m to left, path continues into Hillmotts Wood, down to bend right then left, an uphill track through Cave Wood. Cross field aiming for large tree, right of the cottages to a stile. Cross Hedgerley Lane to gates, track and footpath over M40. Descend steps on left, follow path 1km to Pyebush Lane. Near end take marked foot path on left, under tunnel to London End, continue to left on pavement to your start.
